CAPITAL CAMPAIGN UPDATE

Exciting news!

The Expansion Plans went to Tender April 5.

Twenty general contractors attended a mandatory meeting for interested applicants on April 11th. Tender closes May 2nd at which time, the City will review the applicants and choose the qualifying Contractor.

The plan is that at the May 16th Woodstock City Council meeting, the General Contractor will be approved and appointed. Once approved, we will meet with the General Contractor to discuss the Construction start date.

In June we plan to host an OPEN HOUSE - Expansion Update. This event will showcase the final architectural drawings, introduce the General Contractor, Architect and some of our community donors, share details and the projected timelines of the build with you (Date and details to be determined).

Our Capital Fundraising Campaign continues as we are now raising monies for chattels.

A Wall of Donors will recognize the names of donors donating \$1,000 or more. Room Naming opportunities are still available for donations of \$10k and up.

Tax receipts will be issued for donations of all sizes big or small, as we appreciate them ALL. \odot
